Councilman Yannuzzi updated all regarding the Recreation Board Easter Egg Hunt was rained out on the original date scheduled and was a success on the rain date with better weather and a good time by all. Councilman Yannuzzi also relayed the Rec Board was very happy with the new refrigerator in Light House Hall.

Dawn Jones updated all that Councilwoman Reeves would be presenting the Women's History Month Winners next week at the Regular Council Meeting on April 12, 2021.

Councilwoman Gross thanked Renee Perry with her help at the Easter Egg Hunt and also requested an update as to Aero Aggregate and the problem they create with the dirty air created from their site.
