Motion:

To approve the 2026 Budget.

Motion:

To approve Eddystone Borough resolution 2025-12 that establishes the tax rate for general purpose, and local tax service within the limits of Eddystone Borough tax year 2026. A tax is levied on all taxable real estate situate in the Borough of Eddystone with a total tax rate on each dollar of assessed valuation of 9.1 mills.

Motion:

To approve resolution 2025-13 to establish rates for sewer service to properties and establishments in the Borough. The sewer rental, rate or charges as to all Residential entities as set forth in Ordinance No. 668, section 3, as amended by Ordinance No. 682, shall be computed as follows:

Quantity of Water Used (gallons) Charge per 1000 gallons \$ 6.00

**There shall be a minimum annual charge of \$125.00 for each unit regardless of actual usage.

The sewer rental, rate or charges as to all entities other than Residential as set forth in Ordinance No. 668, section 4, as amended by Ordinance No. 682, shall be computed as follows:

Quantity of Water Used (gallons) Charge per 1000 gallons \$ 7.35

**There shall be a minimum annual charge of \$125.00 for each unit regardless of actual usage.

Motion:

To pay the amount of \$30,555 for Sanitary Sewer Cleaning & Televising – Year 3 . Kelly Engineers have inspected the work and accept it as substantially complete in the accordance with the Contract Documents. Accordingly, we recommend that \$30,555 (100%) be released to the vendor, A to U Services, Inc.



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Motion:

To renew the Accounting Services Agreement (the "Agreement") as of January 1, 2026 by and between Brinker Simpson & Company, LLC ("BSC"), and Eddystone Borough ("Borough"). In consideration of the performance of the agreed services, the Borough will pay BSC \$5,350 per month and \$300 to attend monthly council meetings. Additional services requested beyond the scope described above will be billed separately based on our standard hourly rates.

Motion:

To apply for CDBG (Community Development Block Grant Programs) funds and to solicit public comment for the process.

Motion:

To hire Mark Mickle as a Turnkey for the Police Department.
Rate: \$18 per hour. To start upon training completion.

Motion:

To approve the Consolidated Collective Bargaining Agreement between Eddystone and the Borough of Eddystone and the Fraternal Order of Police, Delaware County Lodge #27, Term of Agreement is January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2029.
